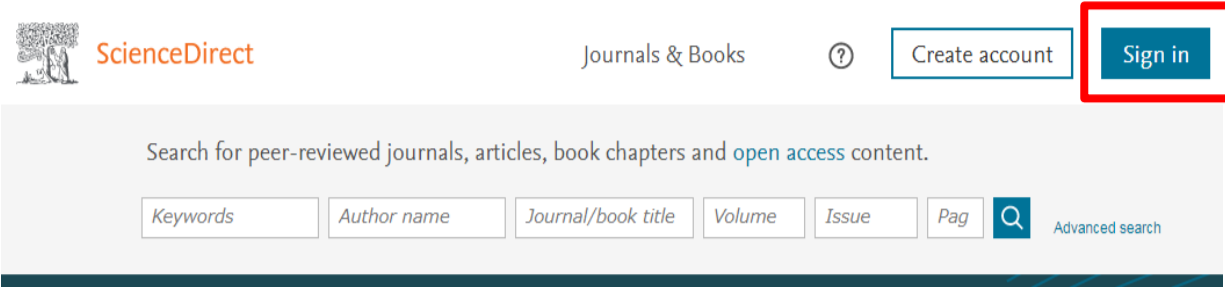
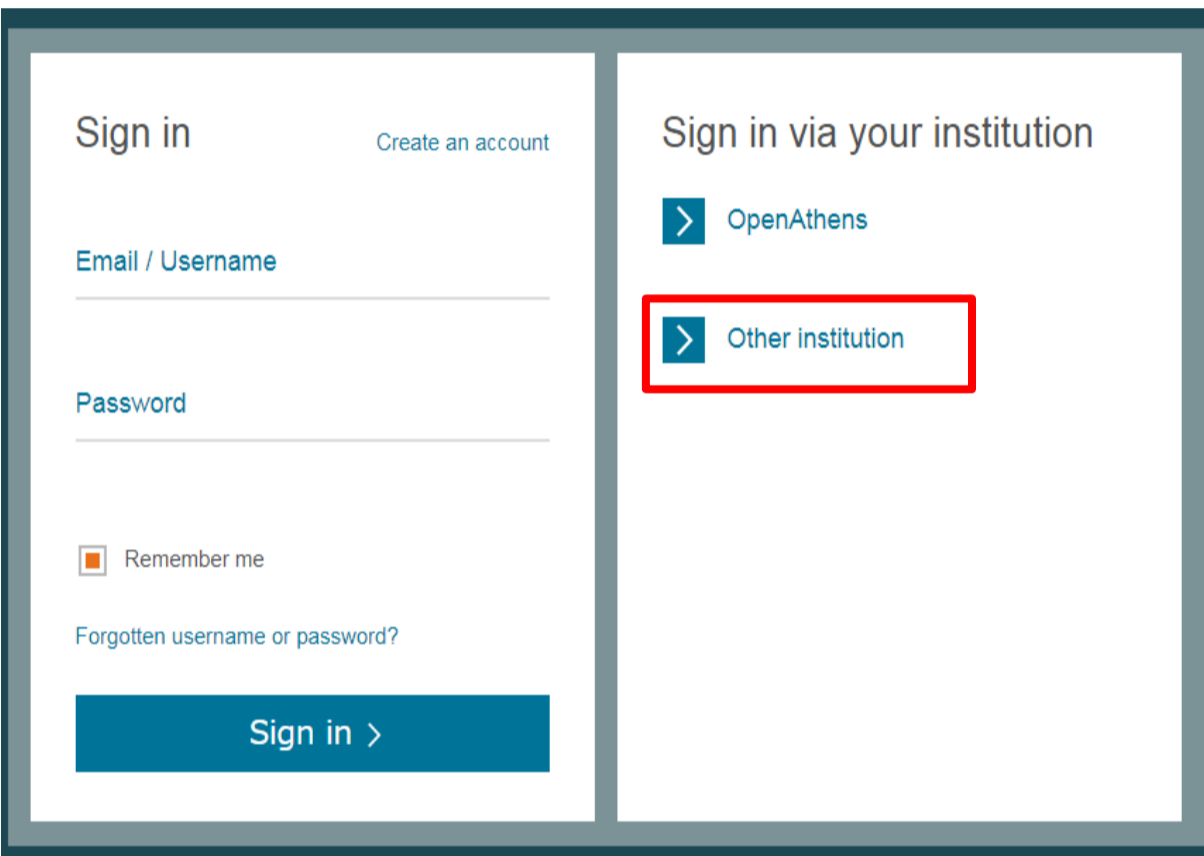


Login to ScienceDirect


